Here are some important reminders...

We need your help

There's still one more week to come into school to **talk to the children about your job**. Please speak to your child's class teacher to arrange this. Many thanks.

<u>Sun safety</u>

- Children need a sun hat that can be kept in school. Please label your child's sun hat clearly with their name and class.
- Please apply sun lotion every morning before school to exposed areas of your child's skin (face, neck, arms and legs. Our staff will re-apply sun cream later in the day to keep protection levels topped up.

School Fund / Snack Fund

Snack Fund is now overdue. Please remember to pay £12 for this half term to your child's class teacher.

i-PAL Payment System

All future invoices will be sent to you by i-PAL and not from school. You will be able to make card payments by logging into your account.

Summer term school uniform

As the weather improves, many children choose to start coming to school wearing shorts. Children may wear **plain green shorts** or continue to wear their green joggers. We often find that when children make the switch to short trousers, the number of cuts and grazes increases so this is something to be aware of. Less padding means more grazes.

- Summer dresses are not permitted;
- Sandals are not permitted as they do not provide adequate protection for your child's feet;
- Sensible school shoes (e.g. trainers) must continue to be worn with short trousers.

End of Year Ceremonies

The arrangements for our end of year celebrations are as follows:

- Children in our Nurture Base Graduation takes place on Wednesday 16th July.
- Children returning to us next year will come along with their parents at 9:00am on Thursday 17th July of year celebration ceremony.
- Children who are leaving us this year will come along at 10:30am on Thursday 17th July for Graduation.
- The celebration events will last for approximately 1 hour 15 minutes and take place outdoors.

Owing to the large numbers and limited capacity, we will need to limit places at these events to 2 adults per child.

As has been the case in previous years, children attend for their celebration, along with their parents/carers.

Attendance and Timekeeping

Please ring the school office and let Joanne Jones know that they won't be in **on the first day of absence**. As a maintained nursery school, we follow the safeguarding procedures and policies of Liverpool City Council. **Any unexplained absence will be followed up as a safeguarding concern**.
