Colour Monster

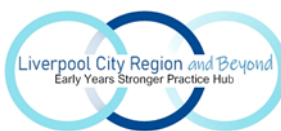

We want to empower them to become more independent in their self-regulations skills and develop their emotional literacy over time. Our staff use the book 'The Colour Monster' by Anna Llenas to support with this.

Children's healthy lunches

- Please check carefully to ensure that **no food items contain nuts or traces of nuts**.
- To prevent choking, please **slice grapes into quarters**.

Safety – drawstring school bags

Draw string bags present a potential risk if children are not supervised. Our advice is to put the drawstring bag in the boot of the car away from children and hang it up at home out of children's reach. You can shorten the length of the drawstrings by tying a knot.

School Fund

Wellies for outdoors

Names on all belongings

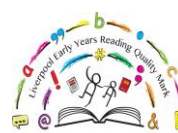
