Childcare Eligibility Codes

Please ensure that your childcare code is **renewed regularly and kept up to date** to enable your child to access their funded sessions. If your code expires, school will need to withdraw sessions. If you are having difficulties with this, please let Joanne Jones know in advance.

Please read the story at home to prepare your child for their groups in school. Books will be sent home every other Friday. Please return books the following Wednesday.

I-PAL Payments

Please **keep on top of your payments**. You will need to regularly log into your i-pal app to check. We do not allow parents to build up excessive debt and may need to withdraw sessions to prevent this happening if an account goes into arrears.

School Library Books

Library Books need to be returned to school on **Monday morning** for children to receive their special reward stamp.

Attendance

Please **telephone Joanne Jones** in the school office **by 9:00am** if your child will be absent from school for any reason. If we do not hear from you, we will follow up any unexplained absences as a safeguarding concern.

Children with vomiting and diarrhoea **must not attend school for 48 hours** from the last incident. Children who are unwell should not be sent to school.

Summer Uniform

When the warmer weather arrives, summer school uniform is **green shorts** with the school logo instead of jogging bottoms. These can be purchased from local suppliers. Children also need a **sun hat** in summer term that can be kept in school. Please label all clothing and accessories clearly with your child's name.
