Owing to the large numbers and limited capacity, we will need to limit places at these events to **2 adults per child.**

As has been the case in previous years, children will only attend school for their own graduation and parents/carers stay with them. **All children and families attend graduation**, both leavers and returners.

Children wear full school uniform for their graduation. Graduation is an outdoor event. Please be aware that in the even of rain, the event will still go ahead. Parents might want to by a poncho or similar clothing just in case, as umbrellas will restrict the view of the children.
