Primary school places

If your child leaves us at the end of this year for primary school, please make sure you apply for their Reception class place by **Thursday 15th January 2026**. You will need to **apply online**. Please be aware that some schools require additional forms, so please carefully check each school's admissions procedures.

If your child was born in the summer term (between May and August), you may wish to keep them with us at East Prescot Road for another year. We call this a 'deferral'. If you are considering this option, please speak to me first.

School Library Books

Every week from now on, children will come home with a library book from our Little Owl's Lending Library for you to read to them at the weekend. **Books need to be returned to school on Monday morning.**

Snack Fund

It's that time again! Snack fund is due. Please send your **£12.00 payment** into school in an envelope, marked clearly with your child's name and class.

Winter Weather

Children should wear a **warm winter coat** for school. The school green school coats are ideal but this is not a requirement of our school uniform.

Children should not bring in hats, scarves and gloves. These go missing and restrict the children's ability to play outdoors. During colder spells, staff limit the length of time spent outdoors so that children do not become too cold.

Snow and Ice

We've been lucky so far! But it is sometimes necessary to close school in the event of snow and ice. If school is closed, **you will receive a text message on the morning of the closure.** This message will be sent to the contact number we have on our file. Please inform Joanne Jones if you change your number so that she can update our records.

Punctuality

If you arrive late (after 8.30am), you will be asked to wait in the foyer with your child until a member of staff becomes available. Please note that **lessons start at 8.30am prompt.**

Attendance

Please **telephone Joanne Jones** in the school office **by 9:00am** if your child will be absent from school for any reason. If we do not hear from you, we will follow up any unexplained absences as a safeguarding concern.

Children with vomiting and diarrhoea **must not attend school for 48 hours** from the last incident. Children who are unwell should not be sent to school.

Children's Birthdays


Birthday cake is not permitted on account of allergies in school.
