What will we be learning next week?

This half term, our theme is **"Amazing Me!"**. Next week, children will be learning about **'My Family'**. Children will be developing their sense of belonging by talking about who is in their family and using lots of language to describe family members.

It would be brilliant if you could **upload a family photograph or a short video clip** of your family to your child's Learning Journal app over the weekend. Next week, your child's teacher can log in and show the children your lovely family photos and videos.

Vegetable Soup

Next week we are celebrating Harvest by working together to make a huge pot of hearty vegetable soup! **Please send in ONE vegetable** for your child can add into the soup, for example, one potato or one carrot.

Nursery Rhymes

Our Nursery Rhyme of the Week next week is **Humpty Dumpty**. Children will learn the Special Words:

- **sit**
- **wall**
- **fall**
- **together**

As you are out and about or at home, try to use these special words as often as you can in different contexts. For example, you might say *"Oh look, our front garden has a brick wall but our back garden has a wooden fence around it"*. By hearing the special words often, children begin to understand their meaning and they become part of your child's vocabulary.

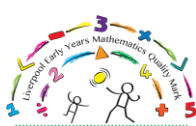
You can also read or say the rhyme with your child and use soft toys and household items to build a wall for Humpty Dumpty to fall off. In this way children will become familiar with the rhyme and begin to remember it.

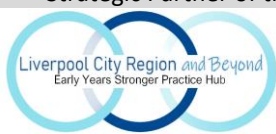
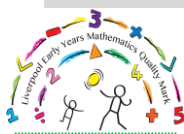
