Sun safety

- Children need a sun hat that can be kept in school. Pleas label your child's sun hat clearly with their name and class.
- Please apply sun lotion every morning before school to exposed areas of your child's skin (face, neck, arms and legs. Our staff will re-apply sun cream later in the day to keep protection levels topped up.

i-PAL Payment System

You should now have all signed up for our new payment system. Please follow the instructions sent to your email if you haven't yet had time to set up your account.

All future invoices will be sent to you by i-PAL and not from school. You will be able to make card payments by logging into your account.

Summer term school uniform

As the weather improves, many children choose to start coming to school wearing shorts. Children may wear **plain green shorts** or continue to wear their green joggers. We often find that when children make the switch to short trousers, the number of cuts and grazes increases so this is something to be aware of. Less padding means more grazes.

- Summer dresses are not permitted;
- Sandals are not permitted as they do not provide adequate protection for your child's feet;
- Sensible school shoes (e.g. trainers) must continue to be worn with short trousers.
