What will we be learning next week?

Next week, the children will be learning all about the **Hindu festival of lights**, **Diwali**. Children will be creating rangoli patterns, tasting traditional Indian foods and learning the story or Rama and Sita through music and dance. Children will use clay to create a diva lamp for you. We encourage you to light this at home and talk to the children about the festival of Diwali. Nursery Rhymes

Our Nursery Rhyme of the Week next week is **Incy Wincy Spider.** Children will learn the Special Words:

- climb
- wash
- out
- dry

You can read or say the rhyme with your child at home and use soft toys and household items to create a drain pipe! In this way children will become familiar with the rhyme and begin to remember it. Don't forget, you can **post your home learning to Learning Journals** so that your child's class teachers can see what they are learning at home.

Flu Vaccinations

Punctuality

Please arrive at school between **8.15am and 8.30am**. If you arrive late (after 8.30am), you will be asked to wait in the foyer with your child until a member of staff becomes available. Please note that **lessons start at 8.30am prompt**. If your child arrives after this time, they are missing out on important learning time with their teachers and friends.











Attendance

Please **telephone Joanne Jones** in the school office **by 9:00am** if your child will be absent from school for any reason. If we do not hear from you, we will follow up any unexplained absences as a safeguarding concern.

If your child is too unwell to attend school, please keep them at home in the warm with lots of snuggles and bring them back when they feel much better. Just give Jo a quick call to let us know that they won't be in (0151 228 4672).

• Children with vomiting and diarrhoea **must not attend school for 48 hours** from the last incident.

Extended Provision

While children were settling in, we were more flexible with bookings for extended provision. Now that the children have all settled, the i-PAL app will request **30 days' notice for any changes** to your usual pattern of bookings.

When you log into the i-PAL app to make changes to breakfast club, after school club and Wednesday afternoon club, the app will automatically calculate the 30 days notice. Please bear this in mind when you are planning ahead.

The sign up/reset email will come directly from Learning Journals and not from school, so please check span and junk folders.

Missing Uniform / Lost Property

Items that are not named will be placed in the lost property basket in the foyer. **Staff will not look for items if they are not named.**
