Dear families,

A very warm welcome back to school for our final term! I hope you had an enjoyable break last week, despite the poor weather.

We have an eventful and exciting half term ahead of us. Our theme for this half term is **"Come Fly With Me"**, as children explore and learn about travel, holidays and journeys. Children will be learning about going to the seaside and about different countries, languages, foods and cultures. We have our school trip to **Windmill Farm** in a few weeks' time, our annual **Beach Party** in July and our end of year **Graduation** celebration on the final day of the school year (further details to follow in the coming weeks).

As usual, here are a few notices to keep you up to date...

### No access to car park gate

Access to school will be via the **front door only** from Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June for **all children**. This is to allow improvement works to be carried out in the school car park. The car park will be closed. We anticipate that site works will take 2 weeks to complete. There will be no access to the school car park for any reason during this period for health and safety reasons.

For the next fortnight, **all children, parents and visitors will enter school via the main front door. Collection of all children will also be via the main front door only.**

Drop off and pick up times will not change. Many thanks for your cooperation and understanding.

### Sun Hats

Children **require a sun hat** in school. Please make sure your child's sun hat is labelled clearly with their name. We advise that children leave a sun hats in school rather than taking them home at the end of the day.

### Sun Screen/ Sun Cream

Please apply sun cream to exposed areas of children's skin **before they come to school**, especially arms, legs and faces. In very sunny weather, staff will support children to apply sun cream throughout the day to keep protection levels topped up. School provides hypoallergenic sun cream. If your child is allergic to sun cream, please inform your child's class teacher.

### Attendance and Safeguarding

Please **telephone Joanne Jones** in the school office **by 9am** if your child will be absent from school. If we do not hear from you or if we do not have a valid reason recorded in our system, it is now standard procedure in schools that all unexplained absences are followed up as **safeguarding**

**concerns.** Please do ensure that you ring school as soon as you know that your child will be absent for any reason.

### 30 hour codes

Please keep on top of your 30 hour codes as some of these are flagging up as needing to be renewed. If your child is entitled to 30 hours, please ensure that you **regularly renew your code** to ensure they can keep their funded place with us.

### After School Club closure

### Footwear

Please ensure your child wear appropriate footwear for school. **Trainers and pumps are ideal** for the summer months. Jelly shoes and sandals do not provide enough protection and result in children tripping and falling over.

### Snack Fund
