A few reminders...

- Ensure your child arrives promptly at 8.30am.
- We will not hold the coach for latecomers.
- Collect children from school at 3:00pm
- No breakfast club or after school club on the day of the trip.
- Children need a packed lunch in a throw-away bag and a disposable bottle of water.
- No lunch boxes or plastic containers
- Parent helpers, please bring your own lunches
- School uniform, please
- Comfortable shoes (trainers are ideal)

## Sun safety

- **Children need a sun hat** that can be kept in school. Please label your child's sun hat clearly with their name and class.
- **Please apply sun lotion every morning before school** to exposed areas of your child's skin (face, neck, arms and legs). Our staff will re-apply sun cream later in the day to keep protection levels topped up.
