Each week, I send out a weekly letter with information about forthcoming events, important reminders and other items of interest. My weekly letter is also posted on our school website.

## **Door opening times**

Children should arrive at school by 8.30am at the latest. At the start of the school day, parking can be an issue when the school is at full capacity. For this reason, the **main doors are open for a 15-minute period** as follows:

	<b>Door opens</b>	<b>Door closes (children are 'late' after this time)</b>
<b>Morning drop off</b>	8.15am	8.30am

At collection times, we open the doors **10 minutes before the end of the session** to allow the opportunity time for parents and staff to speak to each other about the day, as follows:

	<b>Door opens</b>	<b>Door closes (children are 'late' after this time)</b>
<b>End of morning session</b>	11.05am	11.15am
<b>End of afternoon session</b>	2.50pm	3.00pm

- Morning only children must be collected by 11.15am
- All day children must be collected by 3.00pm, unless they are attending our After School Club.

## **Early Pick up at 2:30pm**

If you need to collect your child before 2.50pm because they have siblings in other schools, we can accommodate an early collection time of 2.30pm. This is by prior arrangement only.

## **Wellies for outdoors**

Children will need a pair of wellington boots that can be kept in school for outdoor sessions. Please make sure that your child's name is clearly marked on their wellies. Please also talk to your child about what their wellies look like, so that they can learn to recognise which wellies belong to them.
